Contributed funds buy building materials, and donated labor builds new homes or sometimes rehabilitates existing ones. These homes are then sold at no profit and no interest to partner families. Mortgage payments are used to build additional homes. Fort Wayne Habitat for Humanity is affiliated with Habitat for Humanity International.
