



Ross Medical Education Center looking to fill 50 openings

Ross Medical Education Center, with 14 campus locations in southeast and west Michigan, is looking to fill 50 positions, primarily for instructors and administrative staff.

The vocational school will be participating in the **Land That Job! Career Expo** on Tuesday, May 24, from 9 a.m.-3 p.m. at the Johnson Center, located at 3750 Cleary Drive in Howell, Michigan.

However, job seekers don't have to wait until the fair to apply for the jobs according to recruiting director Doreen Kephart. They can apply online now.

"Ross provides hands-on training," Kephart said, "so we look for instructors who are certified in their fields and have more than three years of work experience."

Kephart said that right now, Ross is looking for medical assisting, medical billing and dental assisting instructors. The jobs are part-time and pay between \$18.50 and \$21 per hour.

"Many of our instructors teach here as a second job," Kephart said. "We have morning, afternoon and evening classes available."

In addition to instructors, Kephart added they Ross has many administrative and sales-related positions available. "We will be recruiting for admissions, financial aid and career development at the job fair," she said. "If you have any kind of business or sales background, you'll likely find a job that fits at Ross."
